

# **BYC SAILING INSTRUCTION (SI) AMENDMENT**

**Amendment Number : 2**

**Regatta : PITCH**

**Date : 31 AUG 2011**

**Section Amendment : 5.3**

**Description : SI 5.3 shall read as follows  
(substitute this language for the language originally printed  
in the Sailing Instructions):**

After completing the first leg of the course, a boat shall not cross the starting line. A boat shall not cross the finishing line until she is completing the last leg of the course and finishes. A boat that breaks this rule shall not correct her error. However, she will be exonerated if she takes a Two-Turns Penalty (see Rule 44.2). This changes Rule 28.1. On a leg of the course that passes the start and finish lines, boat may leave the lines between S and F either to port or to starboard.

For reasons of safety, on legs of the course that pass the start and finish lines, the start and finish lines and the buoys S and F are, taken together, one obstruction, and therefore Rules 19 and 20 may apply between boats while they are approaching and passing these lines.
